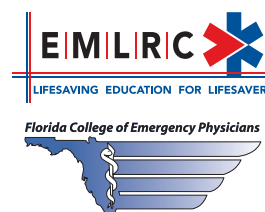

Program Objectives

Following the completion of the conference, participants will be able to:

- ~ Enumerate and explain the most commonly used surgical techniques in congenital heart disease.
- ~ Apply knowledge about surgical correction to better treat post-operative patients.
- ~ Develop a consistent methodology for the approach to and work-up of adult patients with repaired congenital heart disease.
- ~ Distinguish patients in need of transfer to a burn center.
- ~ Classify burns by depth and determine TBSA burn.
- ~ Explain treatment goals for fluid resuscitation.
- ~ Summarize local burn wound care strategies.
- ~ Prioritize care for burned patients.
- ~ Discuss subtle ECG findings in acute coronary syndrome that optimize recognition of acute ST-elevation myocardial infarction.
- ~ Recognize and discuss optimal recognition of acute coronary syndrome in right and left heart block.
- ~ Recognize and discuss acute coronary syndrome mimics.
- ~ Recognize and discuss other interesting ECG findings that represent serious disease.
- ~ Clearly distinguish the categories of rescue airway devices available, along with their indications and contra-indications.
- ~ Describe and apply a rational algorithm to appropriately use rescue airway devices.
- ~ Utilize a rescue airway device to either oxygenate and ventilate a patient, or facilitate the placement of an endotracheal tube.
